Upon successful completion of the course, students will gain the knowledge and skills to define and describe various roles of the company officer, including traditional and non-traditional responsibilities. They will also be able to discuss challenges, laws, and liability related to these roles. Additionally, students will learn about different leadership styles, such as effective leaders, traits, and motivation theories like Maslow's hierarchy of needs and Herzberg's motivation-hygiene theory. The course will cover organizational management topics, including sources of power, ethical behavior, and decision-making processes. Students will also study communication strategies, delegation, planning, and changing policies and procedures. Furthermore, they will learn about the company officer's role in safety, accident investigations, and incident management exercises. In a more specialized module, students will focus on developing strategy and tactics for specific scenarios and participate in practical exercises to enhance their skills. They will also explore the use of size-up techniques and develop an understanding of critical incident stress management. Moreover, students will learn about various leadership styles and traits, including effective leadership, mission, vision, goals, and objectives. They will also gain insight into organizational tables, responsibilities of a manager, types and characteristics of planning, delegation principles, and advantages of proper delegation. The course will cover essential topics such as managing diversity, leadership versus management, communication strategies, active listening, formal and informal communications, discipline, changing policies, updating procedures, accident investigations, incident action plans, and the use of size-up techniques. Students will also participate in incident management exercises to apply their knowledge and skills. Upon completion of Version 2, students will have gained additional expertise in identifying specific actions to be taken during active shooter incidents and understanding the command structure when called upon by law enforcement officials. This specialized training prepares students for emergency situations, equipping them with the necessary skills to manage complex scenarios effectively.
