The series revolves around Magnus Bane and Alec Lightwood, tackling many of Magnus's untouched secrets and stories from his past, his future, and his present and will follow the progression of Magnus and Alec's relationship previously unseen in the other books. The title is derived from Hamlet, Act 3 Scene 3.](#) [\[1\]](#) The titles for the three installments were already decided before its announcement, but in September 2017, the order of the books were switched around to the current order. [\[2\]](#) The books were initially planned to be released as an adult series, but after the first installment was done, the publishers thought it more accurate to publish them as YA, or young adult. [\[3\]](#) [\[4\]](#) The covers for the series were initially intended to all be illustrated by Anne Lambelet. [\[5\]](#) However, by the time *The Lost Book of the White* and the paperback for *The Red Scrolls of Magic* were to be released, the publisher decided to switch the covers to being designed by Cliff Nielsen to match the other series. [\[6\]](#) [\[7\]](#) [References](#) [The Eldest Curses books are another Shadowhunters series by Cassandra Clare, but this one is co-written with Wesley Chu. However, this world has expanded so much the first Shadowhunters book came out more than a decade before the first Eldest Curses novel that it becomes more and more important to read the other books first. While *The Eldest Curses* follows its own adventure, its characters first appear in *The Mortal Instruments*. That background and context is incredibly important to enjoy and understand the depth of this story. If you begin by reading *The Eldest Curses* books, there will be spoilers for the previous series. However, below you will find the two books which have been published so far. While we have a title, there has not been a release date for the third book yet. One of the best ways to read *The Eldest Curses* books then, is by following Cassandra Clare's recommendation for the Shadowhunter world.
