Security academy in houston

In Texas, a person who is working security needs to be registered with the Texas Department of Public Safety. This cannot be done unless a person has been hired by a security company. Once hired, a person will go through the necessary steps of being fingerprinted, trained and apply for registration. The entire security guard training and licensing process can take between one and two months from the time a person is hired, to when they receive their registration card (pocket card) from the state. The first step to becoming a security guard in Texas is applying for open security guard jobs with Texas security companies. These jobs are often listed on local job search engines, or some people just go to the actual company site and request an application. Most security companies in Texas like a person to be at least 18 and having successfully completed high school prior to applying with the company. They also must be able to pass a background check screening and fingerprinting. Once a person is hired by a Texas security company, they will need to complete either level II or level III training. The company will inform you of what requirements they have. In Texas, security guard training may take place at the site of the where a person was hired, or a security guard may be required to complete their training elsewhere. Upon completing level II or level III training, a person will receive a certificate of completion. This will be one of the items needed when applying for a registration card through the Texas Department of Public Safety. Along with the certificate showing that you completed security guard training in Texas, you will also need to provide a receipt showing that you have completed fingerprinting/background check. There are instructions for how to schedule a fingerprinting in Texas on this website: www.dps.texas.gov. Along with the certificate, and receipt of fingerprinting, a person applying for security guard registration card (pocket card) in Texas will also need to submit a photocopy of their driver's license or state ID card. You can then apply for the license online at: www.txdps.state.tx.us or print and mail all the corresponding documents. Even if you apply online (and pay the fee online) you will still need to send in the required documents. The pocket card in Texas is good for 2 years. At that time it will need to be renewed, either by mail or online. Online requires that the earliest a person can renew is 60 days before expiration. If you are renewing by mail it can be done up to 90 days before expiration. A person can renew their pocket card up to a year after it expires, but late fees will be applied. Otherwise, a person will have to begin the process from the beginning. A person needs to be employed before they can apply for their registration and pocket card. Some people opt to complete their security guard training certificates prior to applying for work. Keep in mind that these courses cost money, and a person may still need to undergo individual company training upon being hired by a security company. This said, completing a security guard training course in Houston prior to applying may make a person a more desirable candidate. In Houston there are actual security guard training academies and programs. These are offered to people who are wishing to pursue a career in law enforcement, beginning at the security level. These training academies will equip a person with basic knowledge and skills needed to work security. Some of the sites offer weapons training as well, though there are more requirements of people who want to work as an armed security guard, than those without weapons. Houston security companies employ guards to work these sites. Armed Security Guard Training in Texas The basic requirements for unarmed guards in Texas also apply to armed guards in Texas. A person needs to be employed by a security company and registered through the Texas Department of Public Safety. In addition, to work as an armed security guard in Texas a person has to be at least 21, and have completed their firearms training courses which include firearms safety, use, and laws. A firearms permit needs to be acquired within Texas, and the registration card through the state must show that they are approved to carry a weapon on the job. The training requirements in Texas for armed guards mandate that a person complete all three levels of training prior to receiving armed guard clearance. Eligibility for Training Programs On September 1, 2017, House Bill 1508 (85th Leg., Reg. Sess.) becomes effective. This bill places requirements on entities offering educational training programs that prepare an individual for an initial occupational license. This includes level III and level IV training schools, as well as guard companies that offer in-house level II training. These training providers must notify each enrollee of the following: The potential ineligibility of an individual who has been convicted of a criminal offense; The department's current eligibility guidelines (the board's administrative rules) issued under Occupations Code, Section 53.025; Any other state or local restriction or guideline used by the department to determine the eligibility of an individual who has been convicted of an offense; and The right to request a criminal history evaluation under Occupations Code Section 53.102. Pursuant to HB 1508, if an individual is denied an occupational license based on their criminal history and the training provider failed to provide the individual the above information, the training provider will be required to refund the amount of any tuition paid and corresponding application and examination fees. Please be advised under the Private Security Act (Occ. Code Chapter 1702) and Administrative Rule 35.4 (37 Tex. Admin. Code 1), a criminal conviction may disqualify you from a registration, commission or license under the Act. You may wish to review Rule 35.4's list of disqualifying offenses and the related periods of ineligibility, available on the department's website. You also have a right to request from the department a criminal history evaluation letter under Occupations Code Section 53.102. " Want to attend one of our security training classes?
