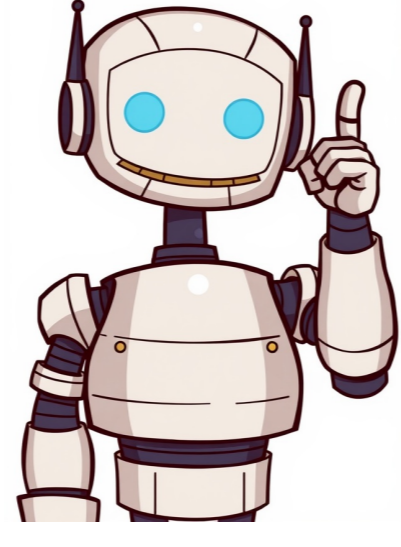

Although the product has a gel-like consistency that's somewhat thicker than usual serum formulations, it's still labeled as 'serum+crème'. This product is surprisingly non-greasy and non-sticky. Within seconds of applying it to your skin, it absorbs completely. Although excessive application can leave a thin layer on your skin, two pumps are sufficient for one time use. If you plan to apply this serum daily twice, the product should last around a month. Although no product can transform your skin into a radiant body as claimed by many cosmetics companies, Lotus Organics Precious Brightening Serum+Crème has undoubtedly shown positive effects on my skin. There's been a noticeable 20-30% improvement in skin texture, reducing dullness and making it appear clearer. I've come to realize that this product can serve as an excellent cream for individuals with normal to oily skin, particularly those who dislike using moisturizing creams during summers due to their drying properties. Although it provides just the right amount of moisture, I generally shun any cream during summers. So I think I have found a good optioin for this purpose. Other than this, as I told that disodium EDTA is a penetration enhancer, I can use it to help some other things penetrate my skin beter, like som vitamins. I can mix this product with it (for eg. Vitamin E) to improve its penetration. If you us it this way, make shure you are mixing something as natural as possible; you dont want chemicles from the other product to penetrate your skin more. This product has transparent and satisfactory labeling, no artificial strong odor, and no harmful preservatives. It gives just the right amout of moistur for normal skin and has good results. Suitable for all skin types, with no significant con (except I wish it were a little cheaper). Although a little expensive, it is a good serum/cream with good results.
