I know this subject has come up before, but I need a bit more advice on this. Our 30 year old mid-century modern house has an old Nu-Tone intercom (with radio) system. The units look pretty dated and do not function well. I know there are more modern wireless systems for music throughout the house, etc. But we still have these ugly units in the walls. Rather than paying someone to take these out and patch up walls (including many with wallpaper), would it not make more sense to get intercom replacements that will go into the existing holes? I think from a labor standpoint it might even be cheaper, since little or no wall repair would be needed? I would very much appreciate any advice I can get on this. All three of these options serve as replacements for almost any old M&S Systems, Nutone, Broan, and AudioTech Intercom systems. In addition, you are able to re-use the existing wire with all three options. Faceplates also come with these systems so that patching walls is not necessary. However, you will need to check these sizes. Custom make intercom frames are available if sizing is a problem.
