Daily Wordle Challenge: Crack the Code and Claim Your Victory In Wordle daily mode, you're presented with a chain of words that all players must guess. You can play with 5-letter words or longer, making it exciting to challenge your friends. The main goal is to solve the hidden word in six attempts or less. Each attempt allows you to enter any word from 4 to 11 letters, and depending on what you choose, the letters will be highlighted in three colors - red for unknown letters, yellow for correct but misplaced positions, and green for correctly placed letters. To win, you need all your guessed letters to match the hidden word. At the start, using a strategic word is crucial: "CRANE" or "SLOTH" are excellent options due to their frequency of usage. The game uses a dictionary from Letterpress with approximately 275,000 words, updated regularly based on feedback. If an entered word is not found in your bank, try another one immediately. If unsure about your guess, you can also correct individual letters without changing the entire word. You can play Wordly for different languages and dictionaries and even adjust difficulty levels to make it harder by limiting revealed hints. To overcome my weaknesses in the most common Wordle letters first strategy, I began with ORATE. Fortunately, this worked well as playing the top five gave me two yellow characters in 'O' and 'R' along with a single green in 'E'. I was down to just 17 options, according to WordleBot*. The Bot's best Wordle start words were even better: LAPSE leaves 13 answers, while STRIP and SCRAP lower that to eight. If you opened with CORPS, only four options would remain in play.(Image credit: Alan Martin)The five next most common letters are 'L', 'T', 'S', 'N', and 'C', so I try and play as many as possible on my second turn. I had two options here: SNORE or SCORE, and as 'N' is (slightly) more common than 'C', I opted for the former. It turned every letter green bar 'N'. So, SCORE then? Well, no. 'C' was also not in the answer, so it was a letter from positions 11 to 26.How about 'P' (15th) with SPORE? Thankfully it was correct. Just as well I didn't think of SWORE or SHORE, which were also possible.Hopefully you did well today, Wordlers. See you tomorrow.* These were: FORCE, FORGE, GORGÉ, HORDE, ROGUE, ROUGE, SCORE, SHORE, SPORE, SWORE, HORSE, ROUSE, WORSE, GORSE, SNORE, BORNE and CHORE.Yesterday's Wordle answerReading this in a later time zone? The Wordle answer for game # 1,526 was UNION.Hello Wordlers. Although UNION contains a repeated character and only one of the five most common Wordle letters, it's not too hard. It helps that there's nothing especially rare in there.I began as usual by playing ORATE. Today, it only turned 'O' yellow, leaving an massive 193 possible answers in play, according to WordleBot.The Bot's best Wordle start words were far better. SNARE, for example, leaves 19 answers, while TRAIN lowers that to 12. If you opened with SAINT, only nine options would remain possible.(Image credit: Alan Martin)I like to play a mix of 'L', 'T', 'S', 'N', and 'C' on my second turn if possible, and that was easy enough today with SONIC. It turned both 'N' and 'Y' yellow while ruling out 'O' in a second spot, leaving just two options, according to WordleBot.After mulling over my options for a while, I came up with UNION. A little risky as a double-letter answer, but I couldn't see an alternative, so I played it.It was right, giving me a three-turn win, but that was slightly lucky. I cant stress this enough — it makes a massive difference.Without one, you'll be scrabbling around in the dark trying (and possibly failing) to find the right five letters (or possibly fewer) out of the 26 possibles. But clever people (not me) have done the math and identified the best start words based on both frequency in English and frequency among Wordle answers. So use them!Secondly, think about combinations, especially at the start and end. Some options are far more common than others — for instance, SH, ST, CR and CH all feature frequently.Vowels obviously need consideration too: not all Wordle answers will contain more than one, but plenty do, and some even have three. A good Wordle start word should have used a couple, but if they don't feature you might well want to try another one or two on your next go. Plus, remember the Y — this sometimes acts as a surrogate vowel, and is easy to forget. It also appears at the end of plenty of words.Finally, try out possibilities. So long as you dont press 'Enter' you can try possible answers to see how they look on screen. Put in likely letters plus any you know are definitely in the word, then mentally change one to the other available options. The answer to yesterday's Wordle was UNION.A primer on Wordle basicsThe idea of Wordle is to guess the day's secret word. When you first open the Wordle game, you'll see an empty grid of letters. It's up to you to make the first move: type in any five-letter word. Now, you can use the colors that are revealed to get clues about the word: Green means you correctly guessed a letter, and it's in the correct position. (For example, if you guess PARTY, and the word is actually PURSE, the P and R will be green.)Yellow means the letter is somewhere in the word, but not in the position you guessed it. (For example, if you guessed PARTY, but the word is actually ROAST, the R, A and T will all be yellow.)Gray means the letter is not in the solution word at all. (If you guessed PARTY and everything is gray, then the solution cannot be PURSE or ROAST.)With all that in mind, guess another word, and then another, trying to land on the correct word before you run out of chances. You get six guesses, and then it's game over.The best starter words for WordleWhat should you play for that first guess? The best starters tend to contain common letters, to increase the chances of getting yellow and green squares to guide your guessing. (And if you get all grays when guessing common letters, that's still excellent information to help you rule out possibilities.) There isn't a single "best" starting word, but the New York Times's Wordle analysis bot has suggested starting with one of these:CRANETRACESLANTRATECARTEMeanwhile, an MIT analysis found that you'll eliminate the most possibilities in the first round by starting with one of these:SALETREASTTRACERATESLATEOther good picks might be ARISE or ROUND. Words like ADIEU and AUDIO get more vowels in play, but you could argue that it's better to start with an emphasis on consonants, using a starter like RENTS or CLAMP. In this advanced guide, we detail a three-pronged approach for fishing for hints while maximizing your chances of winning quickly.The biggest thing that separates Wordle winners from Wordle losers is that winners use their guesses to gather information about what letters are in the word. If you know that the word must end in -OUND, don't waste four guesses on MOUND, ROUND, SOUND, and HOUND; combine those consonants and guess MARSH. If the H lights up in yellow, you know the solution.One more note on strategy: the original Wordle used a list of about 2,300 solution words, but after the game was bought by the NYT, the game now has an editor who hand-picks the solutions. Sometimes they are slightly tricky words that wouldn't have made the original list, and sometimes they are topical. For example, FEAST was the solution one Thanksgiving. So keep in mind that there may be a theme.Wordle alternativesIf you can't get enough of five-letter guessing games and their kin, the best Wordle alternatives, ranked by difficulty, include:Wheelie, which lets you play one puzzle after anotherDordle and Quordle, which ask you to play two (Dordle) or four (Quordle) puzzles at the same time, with the same guesses.
