Odyssey Charter School is ranked #958 out of 3,704 schools, which ranks it among the top 30% of public schools in Florida. What percent of students have achieved state testing proficiency in math and reading? 76% of students have achieved math proficiency (compared to the 52% FL state average), while 59% of students have achieved reading proficiency (compared to the 52% FL state average). What is the graduation rate of Odyssey Charter School? The graduation rate of Odyssey Charter School is 85-89%, which is lower than the Florida state average of 87%. How many students attend Odyssey Charter School? 1,913 students attend Odyssey Charter School. What is the racial composition of the student body? 43% of Odyssey Charter School students are White, 24% of students are Black, 21% of students are Hispanic, 10% of students are Two or more races, and 2% of students are Asian. What is the student-teacher ratio of Odyssey Charter School? Odyssey Charter School has a student-teacher ratio of 22:1, which is higher than the Florida state average of 17:1. What grades does Odyssey Charter School offer? Odyssey Charter School offers enrollment in grades Kindergarten-12 (No virtual instruction). At Odyssey Charter School, we celebrate the uniqueness of each student and their family. Using individualization and sound instructional practices, we foster each student's academic achievement and life success. We are excited to share that the Open Enrollment window for the 2025-2026 school year is officially open! Important Enrollment Updates: All students must complete the Open Enrollment Questionnaire to secure a seat for next year. The Initial Lottery was held on April 18, 2025. Please check your email address for notification of your child's status. If you miss the Open Enrollment window, you may still submit the Open Enrollment Questionnaire. After the Open Enrollment window, students will be enrolled in the order their Questionnaire is submitted, and once seats are full, students will be placed on a waitlist. Siblings of currently enrolled students, children of staff/board members, and qualifying Title I HOPE students will also receive priority consideration, as long as seats are available. Families who submit the Open Enrollment Questionnaire within this window will receive an enrollment offer and next steps via email on April 21, 2025. The email will include two required links (JoForm and Infinite Campus Online Registration); complete the links and submit all required documents within two weeks (May 2, 2025) to finalize your child's enrollment. If the links and documents are not completed within the two-week window, the offer for your student's seat will expire. We value each of our Odyssey students and families, and we appreciate your continued support and interest in our school.
