Police in Lawrence, Mass., are investigating a video that was leaked on social media that appears to depict two minors engaging in a sexual act in a high school hallway, according to Chief Roy Vasque. Police report that two students at Lawrence High School were captured on cellphone video engaging in a sex act in the hall after an extracurricular event. It is believed that the two students were boyfriend and girlfriend. The underage participants could face criminal charges, as could the people who may "have disseminated the video," according to Vasque. Those charges could include open and gross lewdness and lascivious behavior, as well as distributing child pornography, the chief told the North Andover, Mass., Eagle-Tribune. The video was allegedly filmed in August, but went viral in November around the school campus and on social media. Police do not know who initially circulated the video. "Who sent it to who is really the story here," Vasque told the Eagle-Tribune. "You're basically disseminating child pornography when you start sending this to other people." Spokesman of Lawrence Public Schools Christopher Markuns, said in a statement: "We became aware today of content posted online of a pair of students engaged in sexual activity on the high school campus. While at this time it appears to have taken place earlier this fall following an after-school extracurricular event, an investigation is ongoing." School discipline will be involved and there's potential for criminal charges for these two and others involved," Vasque said. "But I think it's way too early for that. Plenty of members of the community chimed in on social media regarding the scandal. In October 2014, Snapchat suffered one of the most notorious social media data breaches in history. Dubbed "The Snappingen", the incident exposed nearly 200,000 private user images, including many explicit photos of minors. The leak not only deeply violated users' privacy but also put curious onlookers at risk of criminal charges for viewing child pornography. The company pledged to improve security measures and crack down on such apps in the future. Is It Illegal to View or Save Leaked Snapchat Images? Many of the images leaked in The Snappingen depict underage Snapchat users and constitute child pornography. Possessing, viewing, or distributing such content is a serious criminal offense that can result in hefty fines and even prison time. Federal law prohibits the production, distribution, reception, and possession of any image of child pornography. Additionally, all 50 states and the District of Columbia have laws criminalizing the possession, production, and distribution of images depicting sexually explicit activities involving a child. Those who sought out The Snappingen images, claiming they didn't know they were illegal still put themselves at risk. Intentionally viewing any leaked Snapchat content is ill-advised, as there is no way to guarantee the subjects' ages. Don't assume leaked images are legal just because they may originate from consenting adults. What Did Snapchat Do After The Snappingen? In the wake of The Snappingen, Snapchat took several steps to address the breach and prevent future leaks. The company released an official statement emphasizing that its servers were never breached and that the leak resulted from the use of unauthorized third-party apps. Snapchat pledged to improve its security measures and crack down on third-party apps that violate its Terms of Service. The company updated its app to include warnings about the risks of using third-party apps and began more aggressively pursuing legal action against such apps. Additionally, Snapchat worked with Google and other search engines to remove links to the leaked images from search results. The company also cooperated with law enforcement in their investigations into the breach and the individuals responsible for distributing the stolen content. Critics argued that Snapchat should have taken stronger proactive measures to secure its API and prevent the development of unauthorized apps in the first place. However, the company maintained that users should only access Snapchat through the official app and exercise caution when sharing sensitive content. This week, he tried to appear more resolute calling for the installation of CCTV cameras in government offices "to combat indecent and illicit acts", the official news agency reported, external. Saying that the scandal had "denigrated the image of the country" he ordered that any officials found engaging in sex acts at work would be suspended as this was a "flagrant violation of the code of conduct". He was not wrong that the story has attracted a lot of outside interest. Judging by Google's data, search enquiries that include the country's name have shot up since the beginning of the week. On Monday, on X, "Equatorial Guinea" was one of the top trending terms in Kenya, Nigeria and South Africa - surpassing at times interest in the US election. This has left some activists who have been trying to tell the world about what is really going on in the country frustrated. "Equatorial Guinea has much bigger problems than this sex scandal," said Mr Cruz, who works for a rights organisation called GE Nuestra.
