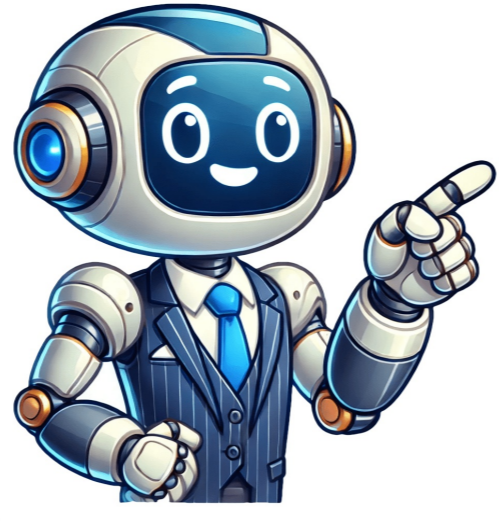

When is the masters on tv

The Masters tournament has kicked off at Augusta National Golf Club, with world-class golfers like Rory McIlroy and Bryson DeChambeau set to face off in the final pairing on Sunday. The event is live on TV and online from April 10th to 13th, with Sky Sports offering extensive coverage throughout the week. Main coverage starts at 7:30pm each day, while featured groups will be shown before that. Additionally, NOW offers a day or month membership for fans to stream the tournament. The stage is set for another thrilling battle at Augusta National Golf Club, where the world's top golfers will clash in the 2025 Masters Tournament. Scottie Scheffler, the current World No. 1 and defending champion, is favored to win, having already claimed two major victories this year. You can watch the Masters tournament on various platforms, including Prime Video, DIRECTV STREAM, FuboTV, and with a VPN. For Hulu and Disney+, you'll need to add Paramount+ for \$7.99/month, or around \$8.32/month for ExpressVPN. DIRECTV STREAM offers live access to both CBS and ESPN for plans starting at around \$86.99/month. FuboTV provides over 150 channels, including unlimited cloud DVR and streaming on up to 10 devices, with a plan starting at \$84.99/month. A VPN can help you stream the tournament from anywhere, with fast speeds and money-back guarantees available from top providers like ExpressVPN. The Masters 2025 TV coverage will be split between ESPN and CBS.
